

Jesus wants us to abide in Him so that we might bring forth much _____ .

Joh 15:4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.

The branch of a tree must stay connected to the trunk or vine of the tree. If it becomes detached it will not produce fruit but will wither and die.

If we want to bear fruit for God we must stay connected with Him. Keep our relationship with God healthy. A branch cannot bear fruit by itself.
