"That's it!" Mother told him, "Cry some more."

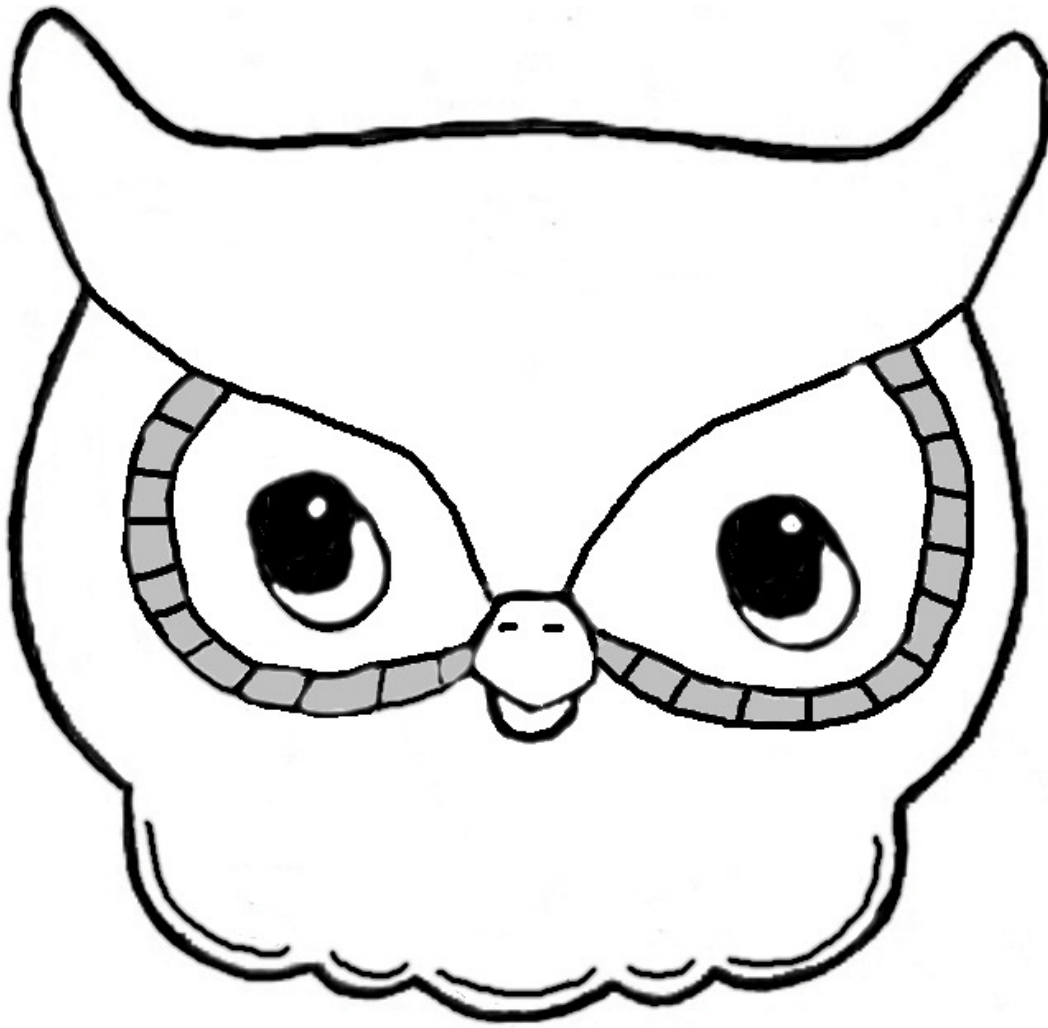
Owlton cried .....

"Boo Hoo, Boo Hoo, Boo Hoo, Boo Hoo, Boo Hoo, hoo, hoo, hoo."

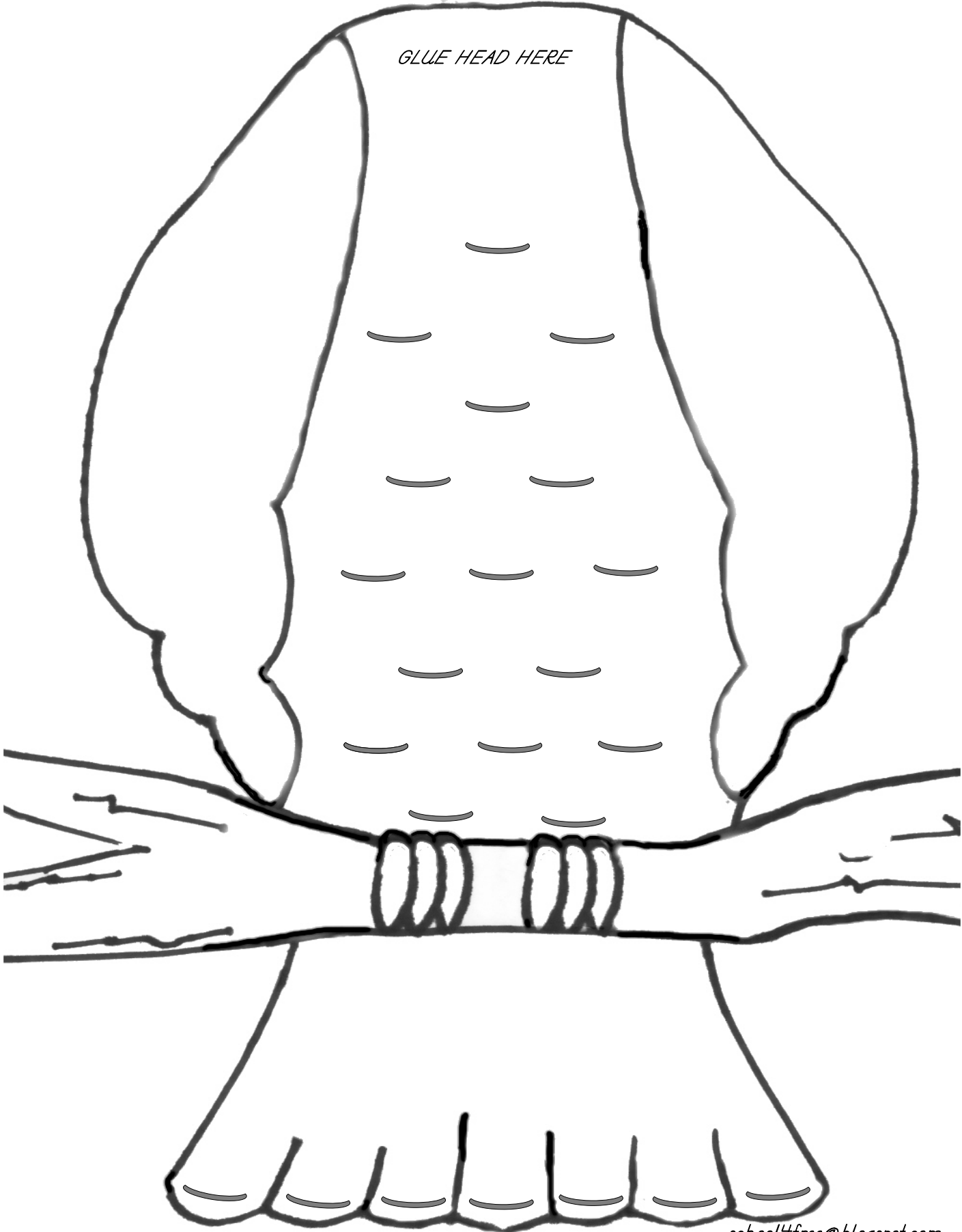
Owlton's mother was so proud.
