Prefix pre

The prefix "pre" means before.

Examples:

Preschool is a school that children attend before regular school.



preheat

To prepare, is to get ready for something to take place before it happens.

Prevent means to take measures to stop something something before it happens.

Predict means to guess about what is going to happen before it happens.

Examples:

Reapply would mean to apply again.

Recalculate would mean to calculate again.

Renew means to make new again

The prefix "non" usually means : not : other than : reverse of : absence of

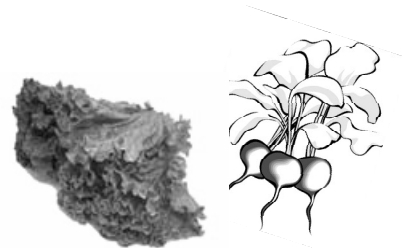
For example: nontoxic (Not toxic)
