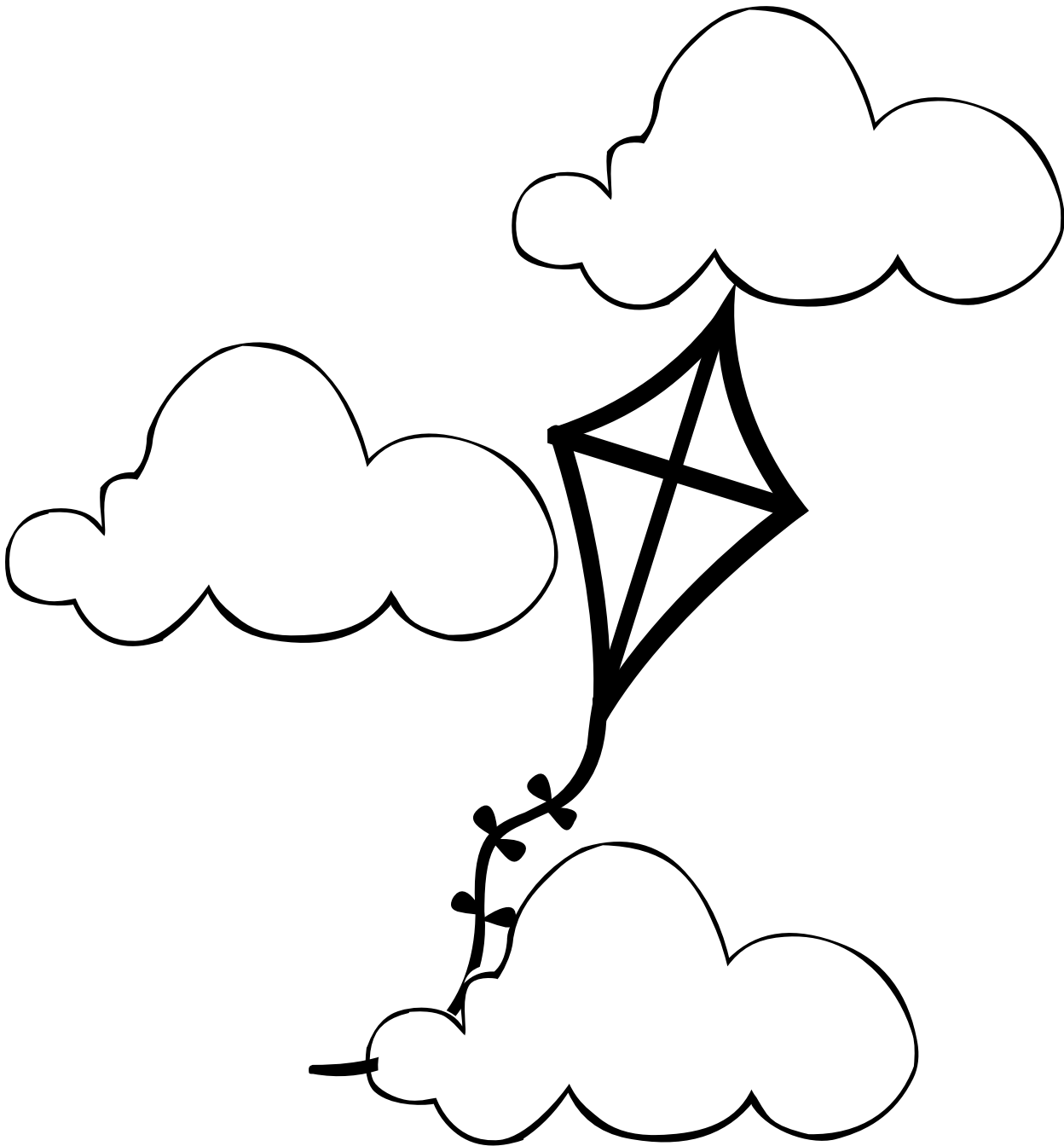
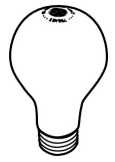

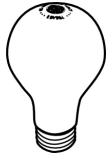
Now add the letter k in front of the word night. _____

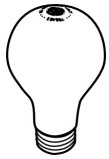
